

VMware Technology Validation - Application Process

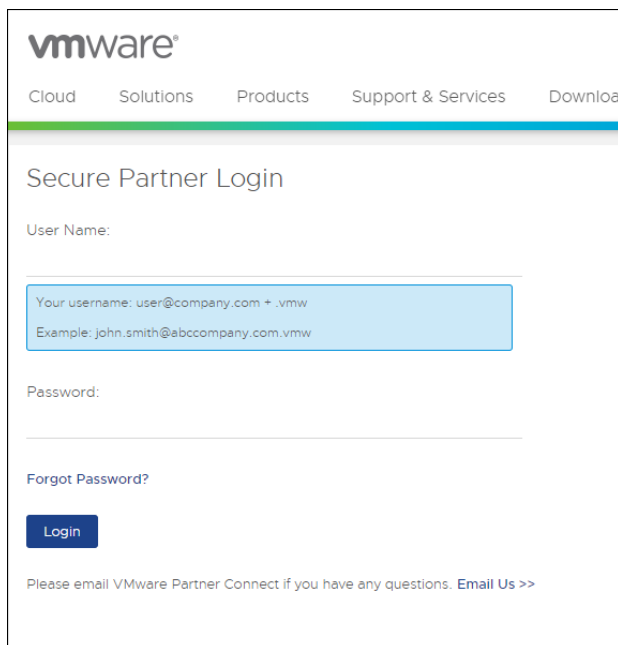
Step 1: Visit <https://cloud.vmware.com/providervalidation/>

Step 2: Select the technology for which you wish to apply.

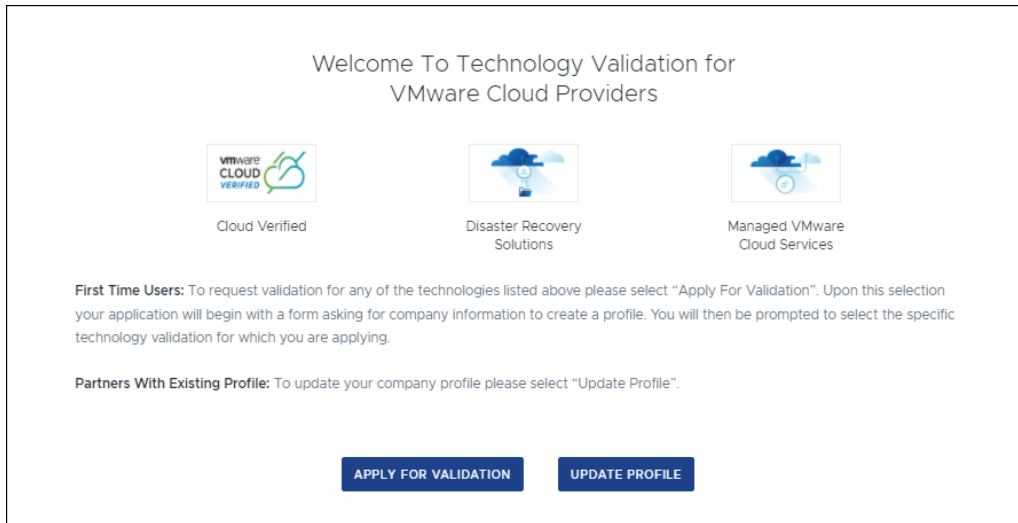


Step 3: Click "Apply Now" to begin your selected technology validation application.

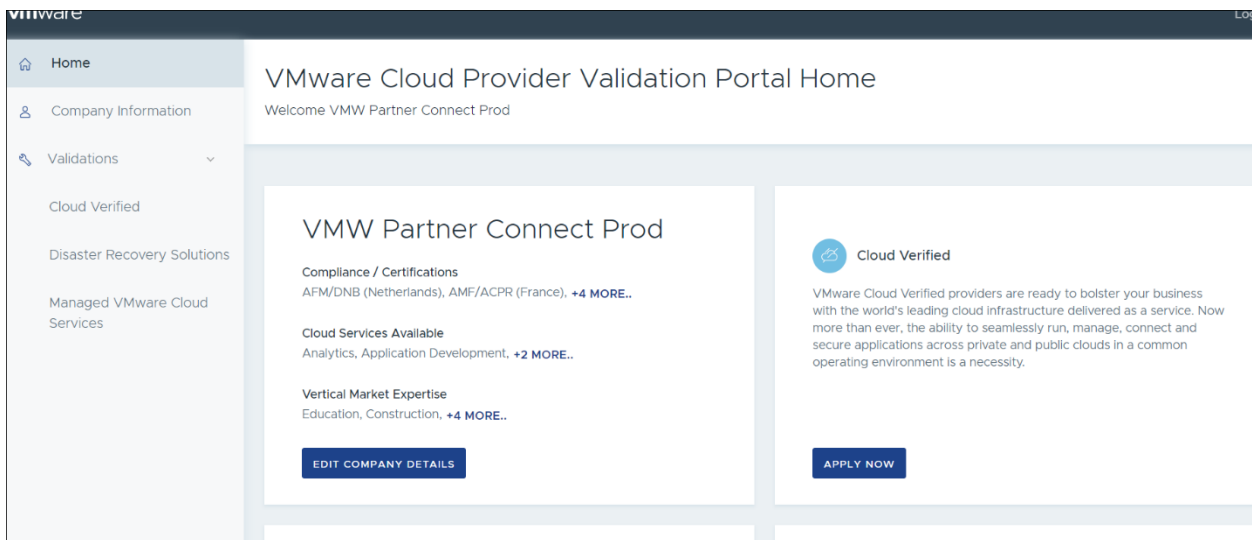
Step 4: Input your Partner Connect login credentials when you see the following:



Upon selecting “Apply Now” you will receive the following message confirming whether you wish to “Apply for Validation” (technology validation as indicated above) OR “Update Profile” for those partners with an existing profile.



Step 5: Select “Apply for Validation” and you will see the following image:



Step 6: Select the Validation for which you wish to apply (in this example the “Apply Now” button shown in the screen shot above is linked to a Cloud Verified validation).

Step 7: Fill out the required information.
